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

Re: Application of Utilities, Inc. of FL for rate increases in Pasco Cnty. Docket # 060253-WS. The reasons for requesting a much smaller increase are many, most important are: 1) Seniors' cost of living increases are NEVER as large as requested by Utilities, Inc. Our increases will leave us behind for a number of years. It will add to the reasons some people move from Florida. 2) The water is terrible! Besides the awful odor, there is a white sediment that appears in our ice, on the sink surfaces, on the heating elements of dishwashers and electric pots, etc. The is also a black substance that builds up in the sink drains. To make the water drinkable, we already have additional charges for bottled water, reverse osmosis or water softeners. 3) Why should the customer pay for water improvement? Privately owned businesses (where we have choices of companies) must pay for their improvements so as to bring in new business and keep their current customers. Please consider this rate increase very carefully and then turn it down.
