RE: **AT&T Florida's Request For Specified Confidential Classification in Docket No. 060822-TL** - Petition for relief from carrier-of-last-resort (COLR) obligations pursuant to Florida Statutes 364.025(6)(d) for two private subdivisions in Nocatee development, by BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc.

FPSC Document No. 02170-07; Cross reference FPSC Document Nos. 01382-07 and 01943-07

On March 9, 2007, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Florida (AT&T Florida) filed its Request for Specified Confidential Classification pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3)(a), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), for certain information contained in **FPSC Document No. 02170-07** to correct page numbers inadvertently mis-numbered in its previous filings on March 1, 2007, identified as FPSC Document Nos. 01382-07 and 01943-07: AT&T Florida's response to Staff's First Data Request, Item Nos. 1, 5 and 7.

On March 1, 2007, AT&T Florida filed its Request For Specified Confidential Classification pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, F.A.C. and Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, for certain information contained in FPSC Document No. 01382-07. Attached to its request, AT&T Florida submitted another copy of the documents previously identified as FPSC Document No. 01382-07: the second copy was identified as FPSC Document No. 01943-07.

AT&T Florida claims the information in Document Nos. 01382-07 and 01943-07, and now Document No. 02170-07, for which confidential classification is requested contains confidential business information related to competitive interests utilized by AT&T Florida to conduct its business and has not been disclosed to the public. AT&T Florida claims that public disclosure of this information would cause harm to AT&T Florida. The information subject to the request for confidential classification relates to AT&T Florida's estimated costs for the installation of network facilities in two private subdivisions, and AT&T Florida's net present value cash flow analysis for the potential revenues generated from those two private subdivisions. The same information is now filed in three separate documents, FPSC Document Nos. 03182-07, 01943-07, and 02170-07.
