TIMUCUAN UTILITIES, LLC AND JEA'S JOINT MOTION FOR ABATEMENT AND CONTINUANCE

Timucuan Utilities, LLC ("Timucuan") and JEA, by and through their undersigned counsel, move this Commission to abate this proceeding and for a continuance of the scheduled actions set forth in Commission Order No. PSC-07-0324-PCO-WS, and in support thereof, state:

- 1. On November 13, 2006, Timucuan filed an Application for Water and Wastewater Certificates for Duval County, Florida.
- 2. JEA filed a timely Petition for Leave to Intervene, which intervention was granted by this Commission in Order No. PSC-07-0131-PCO-WS.
- 3. The parties for several months have been negotiating to resolve the issue of who will provide water and wastewater service to the property for which Timucuan sought Certificates. Those negotiations have resulted in the parties entering into a Memorandum of Understanding under which JEA will provide water, wastewater and reclaimed water services to the Timucuan development.
- The Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") directed that this Motion best 4. filed. The parties are currently drafting an Agreement to implement the MOU. The ultimate outcome when the Agreement is executed is for Timucuan to dismiss its Application for Water and Wastewater Certificates.

 5. It is in the interest of all parties and the Commission Staff not to incur the

time and expense of preparing for a hearing, unless the parties do not reach agreement on the terms of an Agreement implementing the MOU.

WHEREFORE, Timucuan Utilities, LLC, and JEA respectfully request this Commission to hold this proceeding in abatement and continue all scheduled actions set forth in Order No. PSC-07-0324-PCO-WS.
