AT&T respectfully submits this request for application of a "safety valve" for NXX-X acquisition in the state of Florida. By this letter, AT&T requests that the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") overturn a denial by NeuStar, Inc. ("NeuStar", "Pooling Administrator" or "PA") of AT&T's application for a block of telephone numbers and that the Commission authorize the PA to release the requested block so that AT&T may serve its customer.

PLU. D REAU OF REC number pool for this rate center; four of which are 8 blocks and 2 of the 4 are non-contaminated such that they would satisfy the customer's need.³

The Jacksonville rate center of the 904 area code began number pooling on April 1, 2001. Consequently, numbering resource acquisition by a pooling carrier is attained by interfacing with the PA⁴.

On April 27, 2007, AT&T submitted a "Thousand Block Application Form Part 1A" and a "Month-to-Exhaust and Utilization Certification Worksheet – TN Level" ("MTE and Utilization") to the PA⁵ via the Pooling Administration System ("PAS"). One thousands block, in the Jacksonville rate center, was requested. AT&T received an error message indicating the request would not process through the system without a waiver. The PA, applying FCC rules and INC Guidelines, requires a block holder requesting growth resources to demonstrate that existing resources will exhaust within 6.0 months, AND meet the 75% utilization level. The error message indicated that neither threshold was met.

Although AT&T has an adequate supply of telephone numbers to satisfy incremental requests for numbers without receiving a new block of numbers, AT&T's existing telephone resources cannot satisfy its customer's specific need. AT&T acknowledges the Commission's cooperation with similar "safety valve" requests in the past and appreciates its consideration herein. AT&T respectfully requests that the Commission overturn the PA's decision in the interest of our customer.

Attachments 1 and 2 to this request contain confidential proprietary business information. Pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(5), Florida Administrative Code, AT&T requests that the highlighted information contained in Attachments 1 and 2 be treated by the Commission as confidential and withheld from public inspection. 

- 1. Letter needs to be on the Company's letterhead.
- 2. Letter must be dated and signed.
- 3. Service (ADL or LNS)
- 4. Rate Center
- 5. Amount of TNs needed
- 6. Switch CLLI code (this is needed so we can verify the switch can handle the amount of TNs being requested. There are quite a few LNS switches that are capped or limited. This also will clear up if the customer is requesting ADL TNs or LNS TNs.)
- 7. Letter must include if there are any special requirements (such as the TNs must be in a specific range or consecutive, PBX or any other technical restrictions).
- 8. Letter must state that the TNs will be working within 180 days from LERG effective date.
- 9. Letter must include specific Business Explanation and growth.
- 10. If any data is missing, the LOI will be rejected.
