Dear Ms. Bennett:

This is in response to the recent inquiry from staff concerning the estimated amount of a bill for a residential customer in Marianna upon commencement of the new contract for power January 1, 2008.

In our filing, there is an estimated amount of \$91.94 for a customer using 1,000 kWh. This includes the base rate, conservation cost recovery factor and fuel adjustment factor. There would also be a charge for transmission, which we estimate to be \$4-5 for 1,000 kWh, and taxes. Using the initial estimated amount plus an estimate for the transmission would result in an estimate of \$96.04 for a customer using 1,000 kWh.

We wish to emphasize that the impact of the new power supply contract for generation and transmission services are estimates based on analysis at this time. The actual adjustments to customer electricity bills will not be known until the various factors are reviewed and approved in the fuel and conservation dockets.
