RE: **AT&T Florida's Request For Specified Confidential Classification in Docket No. 070126-TL** - Petition for relief from carrier-of-last-resort (COLR) obligations pursuant to Section 364.025(6)(d), F.S., for Villages of Avalon, Phase II, in Hernando County, by BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Florida.
FPSC Document No. 04016-07; Cross reference FPSC Document No. 03525-07.

On April 24, 2007, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Florida (AT&T Florida) filed its Notice of Intent to Request Specified Confidential Classification pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3)(a), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), for its responses to Florida Public Service Commission Staff (Staff) Data Request No. ATT-2. In response to Staff Data Request ATT-2, Item No. 1, AT&T Florida produced documents that contain confidential business information it considers proprietary. The document was assigned **FPSC Document No. 03525-07.**

On May 15, 2007, AT&T Florida filed its Request For Specified Confidential Classification pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, F.A.C. and Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, for certain information contained in FPSC Document No. 03525-07. Attached to its request, AT&T Florida submitted another copy of the documents previously identified as FPSC Document No. 03525-07. The second copy was identified as **FPSC Document No. 04016-07.**

AT&T Florida claims the information in FPSC Document Nos. 03525-07 and 04016-07 contains confidential business information related to competitive interests of AT&T Florida that is considered proprietary by AT&T Florida. AT&T Florida claims that public disclosure of this information would cause competitive harm to AT&T Florida. The information subject to the request for confidential classification relates to telephone, video, and data services provided by AT&T Florida to residences in the Villages of Avalon, Phase I.

Upon review of the information contained in the documents, technical staff concurs with AT&T Florida that the identified information in the documents meets the requirements for confidential classification pursuant to Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006(5), F.A.C., and as such, the information should be treated as confidential.
