Precipitator Upgrades

Law/Regulation Requiring Project:

Compliance Assurance Monitoring (CAM) requirements are regulated under Title V of the 1990 Clean Air Act Amendments (CAAA).

Description: CAM requirements are regulated under Title V of the 1990 CAAA which requires a method of continuously monitoring particulate emissions. Opacity can be used as a surrogate parameter if the precipitator demonstrates a correlation between opacity and particulate matter. Gulf demonstrated this correlation by stack testing in 2003 and 2004 and submitted the results to the FDEP as part of the CAM plan included in Gulf's Title V Air Permit renewal applications in June 2004.

The precipitator upgrades are necessary to meet the more stringent surrogate opacity standards under CAM. The first phase of this project, the Smith Unit 2 precipitator project, was placed in service in April 2005. The second phase, the Smith Unit 1 precipitator upgrade, was completed during May 2007. Precipitator upgrades are currently in progress for Plant Crist Units 4 and 5 and Plant Scholz Unit 2. The Plant Scholz and Crist Unit 5 upgrades will be completed in 2007. The Crist Unit 4 upgrade will not be completed until 2008. Gulf also anticipates the need for similar precipitator upgrade projects related to the CAM regulations for Crist Unit 6 in 2008.
