REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

GULF POWER COMPANY ["Gulf Power", "Gulf", or the "Company"], by and through its undersigned attorneys and pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, hereby files a request that the Florida Public Service Commission enter an order protecting from public disclosure certain information on Schedule CCE-4 of Exhibit RJM-2 to the Direct Testimony of Rhonda J. Martin dated August 6, 2007 (Schedule CCE-4) on behalf of Gulf Power. As grounds for this request, the Company states:

1. A portion of the information on Schedule CCE-4 is proprietary confidential business information regarding contractual matters which would cause irreparable harm to Gulf Power, the entities with whom it has entered into contracts and most importantly to Gulf's customers if such information were disclosed to the general public. In addition, the responses contain information relating to competitive interests in capacity markets which would cause irreparable harm to Gulf Power and the entity with whom it has contracted if such information is disclosed to the general public. The information is entitled to confidential classification pursuant to §366.093(3) (d) and (e), Florida Statutes. Schedule CCE-4 provides the actual price terms and counterparty names for capacity contracts entered into by Gulf Power for 2007. The price terms in these contracts are regarded by both Gulf and the counterparty as confidential. The pricing, which resulted from negotiations with Gulf and the counterparty, are specific to the individual contracts and are not publicly known. Disclosure of this information would negatively impact Gulf's ability to negotiate pricing favorable to its customers in future capacity contracts. In addition, potential counterparties may refuse to enter into contracts with Gulf or would charge higher prices if the price terms were made public.


