On August 8, 207, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Florida (AT&T Florida) filed its Notice of Intent to Request Specified Confidential Classification pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3)(a), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), for certain information contained in FPSC Document No. 06935-07: AT&T Florida's Response to Staff's First Data Request Nos. 2(a), 2(b) and 10.

On August 29, 2007, AT&T Florida filed its Request For Specified Confidential Classification pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, F.A.C. and Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, for certain information contained in FPSC Document No. 06935-07. Attached to its request, AT&T Florida submitted another copy of the documents previously identified as FPSC Document No. 06495-07: the second copy was identified as FPSC Document No. 07817-07.

AT&T Florida claims the information in Document Nos. 06935-07 and 07817-07 for which confidential classification is requested contains confidential business information, including trade secrets, related to the competitive interests of AT&T Florida that is proprietary to AT&T Florida. AT&T Florida claims that this information is not publicly available and disclosure of this data would impair the competitive business interests and cause harm to AT&T Florida. The information subject to the request for confidential classification relates to AT&T Florida's Average Revenue per Unit, estimated costs for network deployment, the anticipated five times annual exchange revenue calculations for Cabana South, Phase II, revenue analysis, and correspondence related to proposals regarding architecture, technology, timelines associated with the deployment of facilities.

Upon review of the information contained in the document, technical staff concurs with AT&T Florida that the identified information meets the requirements for confidential classification pursuant to Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006(5), F.A.C., and as such, the information should be treated as confidential.
