

**TAMPA ELECTRIC COMPANY'S PETITION FOR APPROVAL OF FUEL
COST RECOVERY AND CAPACITY COST RECOVERY NET TRUE-UPS
FOR THE TWELVE MONTH PERIOD ENDING DECEMBER 2007**

Tampa Electric Company ("Tampa Electric" or "the company") hereby petitions this Commission for approval of the company's Net Fuel and Purchased Power Cost Recovery ("FCR") true-up amounts of \$21,121,127 under-recovery, and Net Capacity Cost Recovery ("CCR") true-up amount of \$3,726,521 under-recovery, both for the twelve month period ending December 2007. In support of this Petition, Tampa Electric states as follows:

1. The \$21,121,127 net FCR true-up under-recovery for the period January 2007 through December 2007 was calculated in accordance with the methodology set forth in Schedule 1, page 2 of 2, attached to Order No. 10093, dated June 19, 1981. This calculation and the supporting documentation are contained in the prepared testimony and exhibits of Tampa Electric witness Carlos Aldazabal, which are being filed together with the Petition and are incorporated herein by reference.

2. By Order No. PSC-08-0030-FOF-EI, the Commission approved FCR Factors for the period commencing January 2008. These factors reflected an estimated/actual true-up over-recovery, including interest, for the period January 2007 through December 2007 of \$15,392,712, which was also approved in Order No. PSC-08-0030-FOF-EI. The actual under-recovery, including interest, for the period January 2007 through December 2007 is \$5,728,415.

The \$5,728,415 actual under-recovery, less the estimated over-recovery of \$15,392,712 which is currently reflected in charges for the period beginning January 2008, results in a net FCR true-up under-recovery of \$21,121,127 that is to be included in the calculation of the FCR Factors for the period beginning January 2009.


3. The \$3,726,521 net CCR true-up under-recovery for the period January 2007 through December 2007 was calculated in accordance with the methodology set forth in Order No. 25773, dated February 24, 1992. This calculation and the supporting documentation are contained in the prepared testimony and exhibits of Tampa Electric witness Carlos Aldazabal.

4. By Order No. PSC-08-0030-FOF-EI, the Commission approved CCR Factors for the period commencing January 2008. These factors reflected an estimated/actual true-up under-recovery, including interest, for the period January 2007 through December 2007 of \$23,796,584, which was also approved in Order No. PSC-08-0030-FOF-EI. The actual under-recovery, including interest, for the period January 2007 through December 2007 is \$27,523,105. The \$27,523,105 actual under-recovery, less the estimated/actual under-recovery of \$23,796,584 which is currently reflected in charges for the period beginning January 2008, results in a net CCR true-up under-recovery of \$3,726,521 that is to be included in the calculation of the CCR Factors for the period beginning January 2009.

WHEREFORE, Tampa Electric Company respectfully requests the Commission to approve the company's net FCR true-up amount of \$21,121,127 under-recovery and authorize the inclusion of this amount in the calculation of the FCR factors for the period beginning January 2009; and to approve Tampa Electric's net CCR true-up amount of \$3,726,521 under-recovery for the period ending December 2007 and authorize the inclusion of this amount in the calculation of the CCR Factors for the period beginning January 2009.

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
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
