

Pursuant to Commission Order No. PSC-07-0205-PAA-WS issued in the above-referenced docket, Sanlando Utilities Corp. hereby advises the Commission as follows:

The attached letters were mailed to the current bulk reuse customers of Sanlando Utilities Corp. The fifth bulk reuse customer, Sabal Palms Golf Club, closed several years ago and is no longer a reuse customer. As of this date, Sanlando Utilities Corp. has received no response.

Sanlando Utilities Corp. continues to express the concern that imposing a charge on these customers may result in a reduction in demand, which would, in turn, require Sanlando Utilities Corp. to discharge effluent to State waters. Since the State waters involved are subject to the Wekiva River Protection Act, it is likely that substantial investment would need to be made to meet more stringent nutrient removal requirements.
