By this letter and in accordance with paragraph 101 of the Federal Communication Commission's Report and Order and Notice of Proposed Rulemaking CC Docket Nos. 02-33 and 01-337 released September 23, 2005, FCC 05-150 ("Broadband Internet Order"), the Windstream Local Operating Companies ("Windstream") identified in Attachment A hereby notify the Commission that Windstream intends to discontinue offering common carrier Digital Subscriber Line (DSL) service on a common carriage basis and will offer this service on a private carriage basis effective July 1, 2008 (when the Windstream price cap tariffs are expected to be in effect). Windstream Concord Telephone Inc. currently offers DSL on a common carriage tariff basis from the NECA Tariff FCC No. 5 and the remaining operating companies on attachment A offer DSL on a non-tariffed basis. The geographic areas affected by this change are the areas serviced by the companies listed in Attachment A where DSL is available.

Neither the provisioning of nor the current rates for these services will be affected by this action. The terms and conditions under which DSL will be offered will be available on the Windstream website effective July 1, 2008 (http://windstream.com) and will also be available for review at Windstream's office located at 4001 Rodney Parham Rd, Little Rock, Arkansas 72212. We are required to provide notice of Windstream's intent to discontinue providing DSL service on a tariffed basis. This notice fulfills that requirement.
