1. On June 26, 2008, AT&T Florida filed its Responses to Florida Public Service Commission Staff's ("Staff") Third Set of Interrogatories and Staff's Third Request for Production of Documents.

2. AT&T filed a Notice of Intent to Request Specified Confidential Classification for its Responses to Staff's Third Set of Interrogatories No. 88 on that same day.

3. Pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, AT&T Florida hereby files this Request for Specified Confidential Classification because its Response to Staff's Third Set of Interrogatories No. 88 contains information considered confidential business information related to the competitive interests of AT&T Florida that is proprietary to AT&T Florida. A more specific description of this information is contained in Attachment A.

The information discussed in this Request for Specified Confidential Classification is valuable and AT&T Florida strives to keep it secret. Therefore, such information should be classified as confidential business information pursuant to Section 364.183, *Florida Statutes*. Accordingly, it should be held exempt from the public disclosure requirements of Section 119.07, *Florida Statutes*.

7. Attachment C to AT&T Florida's Request for Confidential Classification is a highlighted copy of the document containing the confidential information.


8. The original of this Request was filed today with the Office of the Commission Clerk and a copy was served on the Parties.



Explanation of Proprietary Information

1. The subject material includes confidential business information of AT&T Florida. In particular, this information consists of the location of various selective routers in Florida, which is treated by AT&T Florida as proprietary and is information not readily available to the general public. Moreover, the public disclosure of this information could threaten the public's safety and security in that it would reveal points of vulnerability on the Emergency 911 service network; and thus, AT&T Florida strives to keep it secret. Therefore, AT&T Florida deems this information proprietary and confidential pursuant to Section 364.183(3)(c), Florida Statutes and thus, exempt from the Open Records Act.
