

Dear Mr. White:

Thank you for your letter to the Florida Public Service Commission in which you expressed your concerns about the application filed by Aqua Utilities Florida, Inc.'s (Aqua's) application for amendment of Water Certificate No. 106-W and Wastewater Certificate No. 120-S to extend water and wastewater services to certain territories in Leesburg, Florida. To give the Commissioners and staff an opportunity to review and understand your concerns, your letter has been placed in the correspondence side of the docket file.

In particular, you expressed concerns regarding the possibility that pursuant to the proposed extension of Aqua's service territory, the utility would draw water from the Haines Creek well. Please be advised that I have confirmed with Commission staff member, Richard Redemann, P.E., that Aqua will be using their existing well, lines, and treatment facilities in Haines Creek to continue providing service to the requested service extension area. As such, Aqua will not be drawing any water from any additional wells. Please note, however, that the proposed service extension area involved in the instant case only includes 22 residential water customers as well as five vacant lots. The 22 residential customers that reside within the proposed extension area are already being served by Aqua via water drawn from the Haines Creek well. Thus, the impact on the Haines Creek well resulting from the amendment of Aqua's water and wastewater certificate to incorporate the extension area will likely be minimal.

I believe that the foregoing addresses your concerns, however, if you wish to file a formal protest in the above referenced docket, you will have certain rights and responsibilities to put on your case, including filing written testimony, participating in motion practice and formal discovery, filing a prehearing statement, attending a prehearing to be held in Tallahassee, Florida, putting on witnesses and cross-examining utility and other witnesses at the hearing, and filing a post-hearing brief. All of these activities will have due dates that will be required to be met by all parties. Although utility customers may represent themselves at formal hearings before the Florida Public Service Commission, it may be preferable to hire counsel or a qualified representative to represent you.

Your petition should be made in writing and should be addressed to the Florida Public Service Commission, Office of Commission Clerk, 2540 Shumard Oak Boulevard, Tallahassee, FL 32399-0850. If we do not hear from you by Monday, September 29, 2008, we will assume that you do not wish to pursue a formal hearing and your letter will remain in the correspondence side of the docket file in the above-referenced matter.
