Dear Mr. Marcelli:

On August 28, 2008, Labrador Utilities, Inc. (Labrador) submitted its minimum filing requirements for an increase in water and wastewater rates. However, on September 12, 2008, Labrador submitted a supplemental filing.

Pursuant to Section 367.083, Florida Statutes, the Commission must issue a deficiency letter within 30 days of receipt of an application. Pursuant to our conversation, it is staff's understanding that only one deficiency letter need be provided, and that the 30-day requirement will begin to run beginning with the September filing.

Thank you for your consideration. Of course, the time for suspending the proposed rates and granting of interim rates will begin to run from August 28, 2008.
