Progress Energy Florida, Inc. (PEF) hereby submits its Preliminary List of Issues and Positions with respect to its Energy Conservation Cost Recovery factors for the period of January through December 2009:

**Generic ECCR Issues**

1. **ISSUE:** What is the appropriate final conservation cost recovery end-of-period true-up amount for the period January through December 2007?

**PEF:** \$1,646,442 over-recovery. (Masiello)

2. **ISSUE:** What is the appropriate estimated end-of-period true-up amount for the period January 2008 through December 2008?

**PEF:** \$1,589,434 over-recovery. (Masiello)

3. **ISSUE:** What are the total conservation cost recovery amounts to be collected during the period January 2009 through December 2009?

**PEF:** \$82,097,033. (Masiello)

4. **ISSUE:** What are the appropriate conservation cost recovery factors for the period January 2009 through December 2009?

**PEF:**



5. ISSUE: What should be the effective date of the new conservation cost recovery factors for billing purposes?

PEF: The new factors should be effective beginning with the first billing cycle for January 2009, and thereafter through the last billing cycle for December, 2009. The first billing cycle may start before January 1, 2009, and the last billing cycle may end after December 31, 2009, so long as each customer is billed for twelve months regardless of when the factors became effective. (Masiello)


