Florida City Gas has appropriately calculated its true-up amounts and purchased gas adjustment factor as shown in the Company's positions on Issues 1-5.

Florida City Gas' position on the issues identified by Staff are as follows:

**Issue 1:**                      What are the appropriate final purchased gas adjustment true-up amounts for the period January 2007 through December 2007?

**Florida City Gas:**    \$719,773 over-recovery

**Issue 2:** What are the estimated purchased gas adjustment true-up amounts for the period January 2008 through December 2008?

Florida City Gas: \$349,603 over-recovery

**Issue 3:** What are the total purchased gas adjustment true-up amounts to be collected during the period January 2008 through December 2008?

Florida City Gas: \$1,069,376 over-recovery

**Issue 4:** What are the appropriate levelized purchased gas cost recovery (cap) factors for the period January 2009 through December 2009?

Florida City Gas: 139.771 cents/therm (before regulatory assessment fees) or 140.474 cents/therm (after regulatory assessment fees)

**Issue 5:** What should be the effective date of the new purchased gas adjustment charge for billing purposes?

Florida City Gas: The factors should be effective for all meter readings on or after January 1, 2009 and should apply for bills rendered for meter readings taken between January 1, 2009 and December 31, 2009.

G. Stipulated Issues

Florida City Gas is not a party to any stipulations at this time, although it believes that it should be possible to reach a stipulation on each of the above issues as they relate to Florida City Gas.

Florida City Gas has no objection to the qualifications of any expert witness.


