RE: Recommendation to Office of the General Counsel - Docket No. 080629-TL – Petition for expedited review of NXX-X code denial by North American Numbering Plan Administrator for Winter Garden exchange by Embarq Florida, Inc.

On October 3, 2008, Embarq Florida, Inc., (Embarq) filed a request for additional numbering resources from the Number Pooling Administrator (NeuStar) for the Winter Garden exchange, (WNGRFLXADS0) switch. Embarq requested 200 new consecutive DID numbers to specifically meet the request of a customer. Embarq cannot currently meet this request given the inventory of numbers available at this time in this switch. On October 3, 2008, Embarq's request for additional numbering resources was denied because it did not meet the months-to-exhaust criteria.

On October 7, 2008, Embarq filed a petition requesting that the Commission overturn NeuStar's decision. In accordance with Commission Order No. PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL, (Docket No. 020087-TL) which approved an expedited process for the NeuStar code denials, staff has examined the Embarq petition and has determined the following:

- 1) The carrier has demonstrated that it has a customer in need of numbering resources;
- 2) The carrier has shown that it is unable to provide services to this potential customer because of NeuStar's denial of the numbering resources; and
- 3) The customer will not be able to obtain service from the provider of his/her choice because the carrier does not have the numbers available.

Since the three criteria of PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL have been met, please prepare an administrative Proposed Agency Action Order to be issued within seven business days of this memorandum (October 23, 2008), as outlined in the expedited code denial process order. NeuStar should be directed to provide Embarq the needed numbering resources to meet its customer's needs in the Winter Garden exchange, (WNGRFLXADS0) switch. Please allow staff assigned to the docket to review the Order before it is issued. If you have any questions, please call Jim Polk at (850) 413-6510.
