On October 28, 2009, AT&T Florida filed its request pursuant to Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, for confidential classification and treatment of the information contained in FPSC Document Number 10372-09 and 10943-09, which consists of Exhibits CAC-2 and CAC-4 that were attached to witness Cindy Clark's direct testimony. AT&T claims that the information contained in the documents are proprietary for the following reasons:

The information contained in testimony Exhibit CAC-2 and CAC-4 includes information that, upon information and belief, is considered confidential proprietary business information to DSLi. The information discussed in the Request for Confidential Classification is, upon information and belief, valuable to DSLi, it treats this information as confidential, this information has not been generally disclosed to the public, and it strives to keep the information secret. Consequently, AT&T believes this information should be classified as proprietary, confidential business information pursuant to Section 364.183(3)(e), Florida Statutes and exempt from public disclosure requirements of Section 119.07, Florida Statutes.

Upon review of the information contained in the documents referenced above, technical staff concurs with AT&T Florida that the information meets the requirements for confidential classification pursuant to Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006(5), Florida Administrative Code, and the information should be treated as confidential.
