Subheadings and subsubheadings at equal indentations shall also be alphabetized. The FPSCR citation to orders shall be listed sequentially in an indentation immediately below the applicable sub or subsubheading. Cross references shall be used to direct the user to subject headings which contain the relevant information. The database shall include the ability to electronically search dockets by docket number, docket title, and document number. The ability to search by rRelated key words (specific words, terms, and phrases) and common and colloquial words shall be available from the "advanced search" feature on the main search page of the Commission's Web site at http://www.floridapsc.com/search. Orders within this database may be searched using logical search terms that are in common usage, that are also contained within the text of the final orders, or by descriptive information about the order that may not be specifically contained in the order. From the Category drop-down selection on the "advanced search" feature for Orders, the search may optionally be further restricted. listed and cross-referenced to the appropriate main subject headings. New subject headings will be added when necessary.
