OBJECTION OF NON-PARTY TO SUBPOENA DUCES TECUM

Pursuant to Sections 350.123, 120.569(f) and 120.569(2)(k)(1), Florida Statutes, and Rule 1.351(c) of the Florida Rules of Civil Procedure, Sprint Communications Company Limited Partnership, and SprintCom, Inc. (collectively "Sprint") hereby provide notice that they object to production of the documents commanded in the subpoena duces tecum ("Subpoena") served by Qwest Communications Company, LLC ("Qwest") in relation to the above captioned docket, to which no Sprint entity is a party. In support of its objection, Sprint respectfully states as follows:

1. The Subpoena was served on Sprint's registered agent in Florida on or about January 26, 2010.

¹ A copy of the Subpoena, which was not noticed to the parties to this case before it was served as required by Rule 1.351(c), Florida Rules of Civil Procedure, is attached as Exhibit 1.

² The Subpoena also names "Sprint, Inc." as an entity from which it commands documents. Sprint, Inc. does not exist as an entity in Florida or elsewhere as a corporate parent, affiliate or subsidiary of Sprint Communications Company Limited Partnership or SprintCom, Inc. or any other entity associated with them, although it may exist under other ownership in an unrelated business. Therefore we do not respond on behalf of Sprint, Inc. over which the Commission would have no jurisdiction.

- 2. The Subpoena commands Sprint to produce the following by February 4, 2010:
 - 1. Produce copies of each and every agreement, whether or not still in effect, entered into since January 1, 1998 between Sprint Communications, Company, Limited Partnership, Sprint, Inc. SprintCom, Inc., or any affiliate, subsidiary or predecessor-in-interest of those entities (collectively, "Sprint') and any competitive local exchange carrier ("CLEC") relating to going-forward rates, terms or conditions (as of the date of the agreement) for the provision (by the CLEC) of intrastate switched access services to Sprint. These agreements include, but are not necessarily limited to, settlement agreements and so-called "switched access service agreements."
 - 2. For each agreement identified in response to this Subpoena, produce documents identifying the date on which the agreement was terminated. To clarify, QCC seeks the date Sprint stopped receiving the rates, terms and conditions under the agreement, not the date on which the original term of the agreement may have expired.
- 3. Sprint objects to the Subpoena to the extent it seeks information from and relating to Sprint, Inc. and SprintCom, Inc. on the basis that Sprint, Inc. does not exist in Florida or elsewhere as a corporate parent, affiliate or subsidiary of Sprint Communications Company Limited Partnership or SprintCom, Inc. and the Commission does not have jurisdiction over SprintCom, Inc. SprintCom, Inc. is a commercial mobile radio service ("CMRS") provider that is not regulated by the Commission.
- 4. Sprint objects to the Subpoena to the extent it is overbroad and unduly burdensome, in that it:
 - Seeks documents and information spanning <u>over twelve years</u>, back to
 January 1, 1998;
 - b. Seeks documents entered into by "any affiliate, subsidiary or predecessorin-interest" of the entities that Qwest names specifically (Sprint Communications Company, Limited Partnership, Sprint, Inc., and

- SprintCom, Inc.) regardless of whether they operate in Florida or are subject to Commission jurisdiction;
- c. Seeks documents related to <u>any</u> CLECs without regard to whether they operate in Florida; and
- d. Seeks documents that are utterly irrelevant to the issues presented in this proceeding, i.e., do not relate to rates, terms and conditions for intrastate switched access services in Florida.
- 5. Sprint objects to the Subpoena to the extent that it seeks information and documents related to intrastate telecommunications services in jurisdictions outside the State of Florida, and thus seeks information outside the jurisdiction of this Commission.
- 6. Sprint objects to the Subpoena on the basis that sufficient time was not provided to produce any documents requested that fall outside the scope of a privilege or a Sprint objection.
- 7. Sprint objects to the Subpoena because it seeks highly confidential and proprietary information when no protective order or non-disclosure agreement is in place.
- 8. Sprint has been in contact with Qwest counsel regarding the subpoena and will continue to work with Qwest counsel to reach reasonable terms on which a response to the Subpoena may be provided by mutual agreement.

WHEREFORE, Sprint respectfully requests that the hearing officer enter an order sustaining Sprint's objections to the Subpoena. At a minimum, Sprint requests that the scope of the requests be narrowed, that confidential and proprietary documents and information be protected from disclosure, and that a reasonable time period for production of documents be established.
