Pursuant to Rule 25-6.0143 (1) (m) F.A.C., Tampa Electric files this report providing information concerning our most recent efforts to obtain commercial insurance for transmission and distribution ("T&D") facilities and a summary of amounts recorded in account 228.1 in 2009.

- 1. Status on Efforts to Obtain Commercial T&D Insurance The property insurance markets remain very restrictive, especially for Gulf and Atlantic coast locations. Late last year, Tampa Electric requested a price indication from its property insurance broker for commercial property insurance to coverer its T&D facilities from storm related damage. Based on discussions with the broker, property insurance for the company's T&D facilities at reasonable costs and deductible levels continues to be generally unavailable.
- 2. Summary of Amounts Recorded in Account 228.1 in 2009— Tampa Electric accrued \$1.333M during January through April and \$5.333M during May through December, totaling \$6,666,667, to Account 228.1 as authorized by Commission Order Nos. PSC-95-0255-FOF-El and PSC-09-0283-FOF-El, respectively. Order PSC-09-0283-FOF-El increased the annual accrual to the reserve from \$4 million to \$8 million per year. The balance at December 31, 2009 was \$29,318,928.
