Gainesville Regional Utilities ("GRU") and Gainesville Renewable Energy Center, LLC ("GREC LLC"), pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), hereby submit their Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification of certain information provided in the response to POD No. 16 in the Staff's Fourth Request for Production of Documents ("Staff POD No. 16"), and also certain information contained in response to Staff's Interrogatory No. 102.

GREC LLC's Confidential Information. The documents provided

in response to Staff POD No. 16 include the confidential proposal COM ____submitted by GREC LLC's predecessor, Nacogdoches Power, LLC, in APA response to GRU's RFP process through which GRU selected the ECR GCL 1 Gainesville Renewable Energy Center as its best and most cost-RAD 1 SSC __effective alternative to meet its needs for reliable renewable ADM OPC CLK 1

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energy. This proposal contains proprietary confidential business information relating to GREC LLC's competitive interests, the disclosure of which would harm GREC LLC's competitive business interests. Therefore, GREC LLC requests that the Commission afford the information provided to Staff POD No. 16 confidential classification.

Confidential Information of Other Proposers. GRU will also submit, to the extent legally possible and as soon as practicable, confidential, highlighted copies of the proposals submitted by Covanta Energy and Sterling Planet, Inc., in response to the RFP. GRU, as the recipient of the binding proposals, remains in possession of the unredacted versions of the binding proposals. However, pursuant to GRU's RFP, Covanta and Sterling Planet designated the redacted material in their proposals as trade secret information, and this information is thus exempt from Chapter 119, Florida Statutes, by the provisions of Section 815.045, Florida Statutes. Additionally, unauthorized copying of the trade secret information is also a felony under Section 812.081(2), Florida Statutes. GRU has requested that Covanta and Sterling Planet agree to permit GRU to furnish the unredacted proposals to the Commission, either under cover of appropriate requests for confidential classification or without restriction. Covanta has declined to give its permission for disclosure on any terms. Sterling Planet has indicated that it

does not object to GRU's sharing its proposal with the Commission, but GRU is awaiting Sterling Planet's response to a further inquiry as to whether GRU is expected to provide the information under cover of a notice to request confidential classification. GRU will furnish the unredacted information as soon as practicable.

Response to Interrogatory No. 102

The table requested by Commission Staff through

Interrogatory No. 102 contains summary information relative to
the pricing contained in the proposals submitted by Covanta,

Nacogdoches Power (now GREC LLC), and Sterling Planet in response
to GRU's RFP. This information is also considered by Covanta,

GREC LLC, and Sterling Planet to be confidential, proprietary
business information, and accordingly, GRU intends to request
confidential protection for this table. An unredacted,
highlighted version of the subject table is attached to the
confidential version of this Notice of Intent to Request
Confidential Classification.

Pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3)(a)(1), F.A.C., GREC LLC will file its Request for Confidential Classification for all confidential information contained therein within 21 days of filing this request.
