Please be advised that this firm represents the Aquarina Community Services Association ("Customers") which constitutes approximately 90% of the customer base of Service Management Systems, Inc. ("SMS"). I have been requested to inform you that the Customers appreciate your services to date and your willingness to share your findings concerning the current state of operations and management of the SMS system. We note that the order appointing you as receiver required that you prepare and provide an annual budget of revenue and operating expenses and that the deadline for establishing such budget has passed. We also note that you are required to file monthly operating reports as well as an inventory of SMS system assets. By this letter, the Customers request copies of these documents be provided to this firm, on their behalf, at your earliest possible convenience.

The Customers further advise you that they have been deprived of receipt of a copy of an appraisal which apparently has been performed on behalf of the bank by GAI Consultants, Inc. This appraisal was denied to the Customers with the suggestion that it was proprietary or somehow confidential to the bank. However, the Customers have been informed that the appraisal apparently has been provided to other parties, including private utilities from which bids to purchase the SMS system have been solicited. The Customers object to this disparity in treatment and request your assistance in remedying such actions in the future to the extent such remedies are within your power to grant.
