# TAMPA ELECTRIC COMPANY'S MEMORANDUM IN OPPOSITION TO OFFICE OF PUBLIC COUNSEL'S MOTION FOR MODIFICATION OF TESTIMONY FILING DATES

Tampa Electric Company ("Tampa Electric" or "the company") files this its memorandum in opposition to the motion filed on behalf of the Office of Public Counsel ("OPC") seeking to alter various dates on the schedule for this proceeding and, says:

This docket was opened in July of 2009 and OPC has been a party since July 20,
2009.

2. The issues to be resolved in this proceeding are limited in scope and principally address whether five combustion turbines ("CTs") and a rail unloading facility were completed and placed in service by Tampa Electric by the end of 2009 and whether the CTs are needed to serve load requirements. These underlying issues were actually identified nearly 11 months ago in the Commission's final order in Tampa Electric's most recently completed rate proceeding. (Order No. PSC-09-0283-FOF-EI, issued April 30, 2009 in Docket No. 080317-EI, In Re: Petition for a Rate Increase by Tampa Electric Company).

3. The December 22, 2009 order in this docket setting this matter for hearing found that Tampa Electric had already met the condition that the five CTs are actually in service during 2009 and that it appeared that the rail facility would be completed by December 31, 2009. There

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simply are not a lot of issues remaining for OPC to address and OPC has known for a long time what those issues are.

4. The schedule in the order establishing procedure appears to be fair and accommodating to all participants and well thought out, especially considering the Commission's busy calendar. In view of this and the limited scope of the issues to be decided, OPC's current proposal to nearly double its time for preparing testimony while significantly reducing the time for Tampa Electric to submit rebuttal testimony is unreasonable and inappropriate.

WHEREFORE, Tampa Electric urges that OPC's motion for modification of testimony filing dates be denied and that this matter go forward on the schedule set forth in the order establishing procedure.
