

RE: Docket No. 080366-GU - Application for a Rate Increase by Florida Public Utilities

On December 17, 2008, Florida Public Utilities Company (FPUC) filed a Petition with the Florida Public Service Commission (PSC) seeking approval to increase natural gas rates and charges to produce an additional \$9,917,690 in annual revenues. The Commission Staff reviewed the schedules filed by the Company, audit reports and additional data requested by the parties. On May 5, 2009, the Commission reviewed and discussed the Recommendation of Staff which was based on the record in this docket. As a result, FPUC was authorized to increase its rates and charges to produce additional annual revenues of \$8,496,230, effective for meter readings on or after June 4, 2009. On May 27, 2009 the PSC issued Proposed Agency Action Order No PSC-09-0375-PAA-GU and on June 17, 2009 the Office of Public Counsel (OPC) entered a protest to the natural gas rate increase. On October 27, 2009 the OPC and FPU came to a settlement agreement for a rate increase of \$7,969,000. On December 15, 2009 the PSC approved a final rate increase of \$7,969,000. The following table provides a comparison of the present rates approved on May 5, 2009 and the recently approved rates. These rates will be effective for meter readings on and after January 14, 2010.
