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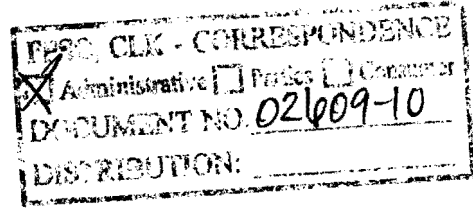

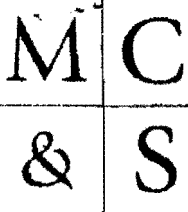



You had inquired about why the TRC, RIM, and Participant tests were the same for the residential and commercial Ceiling Insulation Upgrade programs and the residential and commercial Heating and Cooling Efficiency programs. We responded that we used the same assumptions for savings and cost for both the residential and commercial programs. However, in reviewing the FIRE model runs we discovered that we had inadvertently used the residential non-fuel energy charge of 1.958 cents/kWh for the commercial programs instead of the General Services Non-Demand non-fuel energy charge of 1.927 cents/kWh. We reran the commercial programs with the 1.927 cents/kWh non-fuel energy charge and sent those results to you on August 6. They revise the Table in FPUC's 2010 Demand-Side Management Plan on Page A-5. They did not represent the E-TRC and E-RIM numbers which should be used for determining if a program is cost effective or not since the goals are set on E-TRC. The E-TRC and E-RIM numbers are found in the response to question No. 4 of the Staff's First Data Request. We have unduly confused the situation by providing the TRC and RIM numbers instead of only providing the E-TRC and E-RIM numbers. If you have any questions, please give me a call on my cell.







You had inquired about why the TRC, RIM, and Participant tests were the same for the residential and commercial Ceiling Insulation Upgrade programs and the residential and commercial Heating and Cooling Efficiency programs. We responded that we used the same assumptions for savings and cost for both the residential and commercial programs. However, in reviewing the FIRE model runs we discovered that we had inadvertently used the residential non-fuel energy charge of 1.958 cents/kWh for the commercial programs instead of the General Services Non-Demand non-fuel energy charge of 1.927 cents/kWh. We reran the commercial programs with the 1.927 cents/kWh non-fuel energy charge and sent those results to you on August 6. They revise the Table in FPUC's 2010 Demand-Side Management Plan on Page A-5. They did not represent the E-TRC and E-RIM numbers which should be used for determining if a program is cost effective or not since the goals are set on E-TRC. The E-TRC and E-RIM numbers are found in the response to question No. 4 of the Staff's First Data Request. We have unduly confused the situation by providing the TRC and RIM numbers instead of only providing the E-TRC and E-RIM numbers. If you have any questions, please give me a call on my cell.

Would you please supplement the information below with a brief explanation of the intended purpose of the revised test results that you sent to me on August 6? As you know, I used those results as the basis for my analysis, in which I concluded that the programs with ratios less than 1.00 should not be approved, and that their associated savings should not be included towards the approved goals. If I had not used these revised test results, and instead used the test results submitted in Staff's First Data Request, question 4, then only the Ceiling Insulation program would have been affected, and as you point out below, all the goals would have been met except the Commercial Annual Energy which would lack only 0.08 GWh of being met.

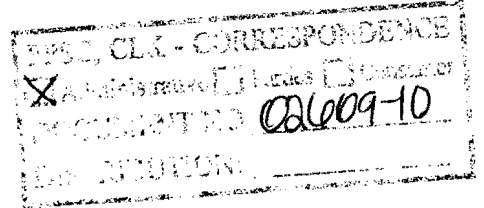

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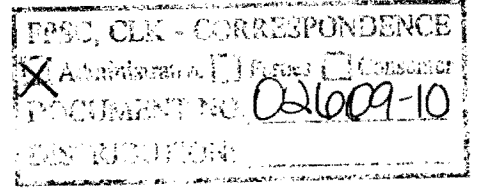

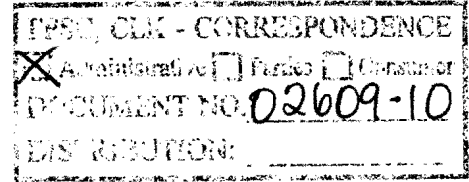
