

You had inquired about why the TRC, RIM, and Participant tests were the same for the residential and commercial Ceiling Insulation Upgrade programs and the residential and commercial Heating and Cooling Efficiency programs. We responded that we used the same assumptions for savings and cost for both the residential and commercial programs. However, in reviewing the FIRE model runs we discovered that we had inadvertently used the residential non-fuel energy charge of 1.958 cents/kWh for the commercial programs instead of the General Services Non-Demand non-fuel energy charge of 1.927 cents/kWh. We reran the commercial programs with the 1.927 cents/kWh non-fuel energy charge and sent those results to you on August 6. They revise the Table in FPUC's 2010 Demand-Side Management Plan on Page A-5. They did not represent the E-TRC and E-RIM numbers which should be used for determining if a program is cost effective or not since the goals are set on E-TRC. The E-TRC and E-RIM numbers are found in the response to question No. 4 of the Staff's First Data Request. Would you please supplement the information below with a brief explanation of the intended purpose of the revised test results that you sent to me on August 6? As you know, I used those results as the basis for my analysis, in which I concluded that the programs with ratios less than 1.00 should not be approved, and that their associated savings should not be included towards the approved goals. If I had not used these revised test results, and instead used the test results submitted in Staff's First Data Request, question 4, then only the Ceiling Insulation program would have been affected, and as you point out below, all the goals would have been met except the Commercial Annual Energy which would lack only 0.08 GWh of being met.

It appears that you are saying I should not have used the revised results in this way. However, I am unclear as to just how you expected me to use that information.

We reran the commercial programs with the 1.927 cents/kWh non-fuel energy charge and sent those results to you on August 6. They revise the Table in FPUC's 2010 Demand-Side Management Plan on Page A-5. They did not represent the E-TRC and E-RIM numbers which should be used for determining if a program is cost effective or not since the goals are set on E-TRC. The E-TRC and E-RIM numbers are found in the response to question No. 4 of the Staff's First Data Request. We have unduly confused the situation by providing the TRC and RIM numbers instead of only providing the E-TRC and E-RIM numbers. If you have any questions, please give me a call on my cell.

Myron,

Would you please supplement the information below with a brief explanation of the intended purpose of the revised test results that you sent to me on August 6? As you know, I used those results as the basis for my analysis, in which I concluded that the programs with ratios less than 1.00 should not be approved, and that their associated savings should not be included towards the approved goals. If I had not used these revised test results, and instead used the test results submitted in Staff's First Data Request, question 4, then only the Ceiling Insulation program would have been affected, and as you point out below, all the goals would have been met except the Commercial Annual Energy which would lack only 0.08 GWh of being met.

It appears that you are saying I should not have used the revised results in this way. However, I am unclear as to just how you expected me to use that information.

I'll wait for your response before following up any further. Thanks.

The numbers shown in Table 5 of the Staff Recommendation for the Commercial Programs for E-TRC and E-RIM are actually for TRC and RIM. When the E-TRC and E-RIM numbers are used from Question No. 4 of the Staff's First Data Request, the Commercial Heating and Cooling Efficiency program is cost effective. Only the Ceiling Insulation Upgrade programs for Residential and Commercial are not cost effective. If only the Ceiling Insulation programs are not considered in Table 3 of the Staff Recommendation, FPUC will meet all the goals except for the Annual GWh for Commercial Programs where the total projected GWh would be 7.72 compared to a goal of 7.8. This is very close to the goals and if the Ceiling Insulation Programs are not approved, FPUC would propose to increase the number of Commercial Energy Surveys by 5 surveys a year which would result in a projected Commercial GWh of 7.82 which would meet the goal of 7.8. FPUC's residential programs are projected to exceed the Commission's Annual Energy goal by over 80 percent. FPUC would prefer to include the Ceiling Insulation programs in their plan. Although the Ceiling Insulation programs are not projected to be cost effective under the E-TRC test, they are a minor part of FPUC's plan and FPUC has been offering a Residential Ceiling Insulation approved under the 2005 Plan. The projected number of annual participants are only 30 for residential and 12 for commercial. Also if the Commission requires FPUC to resubmit its Plan, FPUC proposed to increase the incentive for Solar Photovoltaic from \$0.25/watt to \$1.00/watt based on the Staff's recommendation.






