Dear Ms. Sirianni:

On April 26, 2010, in response to staff's audit of AT&T's LEX and LENS OSS ordering interfaces, the Commission issued a Proposed Agency Action Order (No. PSC-10-0253-PAA-TP) that addresses the retirement of LENS and implementation of LEX. Staff's audit includes the following recommended actions for AT&T to implement:

- 1. AT&T shall conduct LEX volume testing in the production environment or otherwise prove that capacity in the production environment is adequate in the Southeast back-end systems;
- 2. AT&T shall perform a root cause analysis on the reason for the poor flow-through results for the LEX interface and take appropriate corrective action;
- 3. AT&T shall update all appropriate CLEC documentation for commingled orders via the LEX interface; and
- 4. AT&T, STS, and staff shall work together to resolve the specific LEX ordering issues raised by STS in the March 1, 2010 matrix.

On April 1, 28, and 30, 2010, AT&T filed responses to staff's recommended actions 1 through 3 above. Additionally, on April 29, 2010, AT&T, STS, and staff initiated a series of weekly calls to work through recommended action item 4 above. Upon review of AT&T's responses, staff believes that AT&T has satisfied recommended actions 1 through 3, and further believes the parties will continue to work in good faith to resolve action item 4.

Staff believes that ATT has met the conditions set forth in staff's audit report. Staff notes, however, that the Proposed Agency Action Order (No. PSC-10-0253-PAA-TP) does not become final until May 17, 2010. Parties should govern themselves accordingly.
