ENTERPRISE SOLUTIONS LLC**

Verizon Enterprise Solutions LLC ("Verizon") hereby submits this Application for authority under Section 214(a) of the Communications Act and Sections 63.71 and 63.19 of the Commission's rules to discontinue post-paid calling cards that were issued to Verizon's business customers. As required by Sections 63.71(a) and (b) of the Commission's rules, Verizon provides the following information:

1. Name and Address of Carrier (47 C.F.R. §§ 63.71 (a)(1), (b)(2)):

2. Date of Planned Service Discontinuance (47 C.F.R. §§ 63.71(a)(2), (b)(2)):

Subject to Commission authorization under 47 C.F.R. § 63.71 Verizon will discontinue post-paid calling cards for business customers on or after July 1, 2010.

¹ Verizon Enterprise Solutions changed its primary address to One Verizon Way, VC22E243, Basking Ridge, NJ 07920 after the bill message for this discontinuance was finalized for printing. Customer correspondence mailed to the address provided in the customer notices concerning these discontinuances will be forwarded to Verizon Enterprise Solution LLC's new address.

3. Points of Geographic Areas of Service Affected (47 C.F.R. §§ 63.71(a)(3), b(2)):

Verizon's post-paid calling cards were available to business customers throughout the United States excluding Hawaii and Alaska. Effective on or after July 1, 2010, these cards cannot be used to place calls from anywhere in the United States.

4. Brief Description of Type of Service Affected (47 C.F.R. §§ 63.71(a)(4), b(2)):

Verizon's post-paid calling cards were issued to business customers who subscribed to long distance service with Verizon. Customers could use these cards from anywhere in the United States to place long distance, including international, calls, and would be billed for calls made using the card.

The public convenience and necessity will not be impaired by the proposed service discontinuance because there are many alternative providers of long distance services nationwide.

5. Brief Description of the Dates and Methods of Notice to All Affected Customers (47 C.F.R. § 63.71 (b)(3)):

Between April 1 and April 30, 2010, customers in all impacted states except Arizona, Nevada, and Wisconsin, received written notification of the proposed discontinuances via a bill message. Letters concerning this proposed discontinuance were mailed to impacted customers in Arizona, Wisconsin and Nevada via first-class mail on April 30, 2010.

Copies of the customer notices are attached as Exhibit A to this application.

In addition to receiving a written notification, customers placing calls using this service between May 1 and June 30, 2010 will hear the following oral message:

On or after July 1, 2010, Verizon Long Distance LLC plans to discontinue this Calling Card and calls will no longer be completed using this service. We apologize for the inconvenience.

Copies of this Application are being sent via first class U.S. Mail to the governors and public utilities commissions of each impacted state, and the Special Assistant for Telecommunications to the Secretary of Defense, as required by Section 63.71(a) of the Commission's rules. Copies of this application are also being sent to the Chief of the Commission's International Bureau as required under 47 C.F.R. § 63.19 because Post-Paid Calling Card Service allowed customers to place international calls.

6. Regulatory Classification of Carrier (47 C.F.R. § 63.71(b)(4)):

Verizon is considered non-dominant with respect to the services to be discontinued.

CONCLUSION

Verizon respectfully requests that the Commission approve this Application.
