FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY'S REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION OF PORTIONS OF RESPONSES TO THE STAFF OF THE FLORIDA PUBLIC SERVICE COMISSION'S FIRST SET OF INTERROGATORIES (NOS. 1-28) AND FIRST REQUEST FOR PRODUCTION OF DOCUMENTS (NOS. 1-3)

Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") requests confidential classification of portions of its responses to the Staff of the Florida Public Service Commission's ("Staff's") First Set of Interrogatories (Nos. 1-28) and Staff's First Request for Production of Documents (Nos. 1-3). In support of its request, FPL states as follows:

- 1. On April 28, 2010, FPL provided to Staff its responses to Staff's First Set of Interrogatories (Nos. 1-28) and Staff's First Request for Production of Documents (Nos. 1-3), along with a Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification. Pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3)(a), FPL is given 21 days from the date of filing the Notice of Intent, or until May 19, 2010, to file a formal Request for Confidential Classification ("Request"). Pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3)(a), Florida Administrative Code, FPL is filing this Request for Confidential Classification to maintain continued confidential handling of portions of those responses.
- 2. Certain information contained in FPL's responses to Staff's First Set of Interrogatories Nos. 9, 10, 11, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 25, and 26, served on April 28, 2010, is proprietary, confidential business information.
 - 3. The following exhibits are included with and made a part of this request:

- a. The confidential responses were previously provided with the Notice of Intent filed on April 28, 2010. Upon review, FPL determined that certain information designated confidential in the Notice of Intent (contained in FPL's responses to Interrogatory Nos. 23 and 24) should not be designated as such. Therefore, "Exhibit A" containing a revised version of the confidential responses is attached, and FPL requests the return of the confidential attachment filed with its Notice of Intent on April 28, 2010.
- b. Exhibit B consists of two copies of the confidential material on which all information that FPL asserts is entitled to confidential treatment has been redacted.
- c. Exhibit C is a table containing an identification of the information highlighted in Exhibit A, together with references to the specific statutory basis for the claim of confidentiality and to the affiant in support of the requested classification.
- d. Exhibit D includes the affidavits of Maria V. Besada and Patrick Donohoo.
- 4. FPL submits that the highlighted information in Exhibit A is proprietary confidential business information within the meaning of Section 366.093(3), Florida Statutes. This information is intended to be and has been treated as private, and its confidentiality has been maintained. Pursuant to Section 366.093, such information is entitled to confidential treatment and it is exempt from the disclosure provisions of the public records law. Thus, once the Commission determines that the information in question is proprietary confidential business information, the Commission is not required to engage in any further analysis or review such as weighing the harm of disclosure against the public interest in access to the information.
- 5. As the affidavits included in Exhibit D indicate, certain information provided by FPL contains contractually sensitive information. Disclosure of this information would violate

nondisclosure terms of the contracts between FPL's affiliate, FPL Energy Services ("FPLES"), and certain vendors, and would impair FPLES' ability to contract for goods or services on favorable terms in the future. Disclosure of this information would also place FPLES at a disadvantage when coupled with other information that is publicly available. Such information is protected by Section 366.093(3)(d), Florida Statutes. The materials provided by FPL also contain information the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of FPLES and its vendor. Specifically, the information provided by FPL contains FPLES' customer counts, FPLES claim counts, and FPLES financial information. Such information is protected by Section 366.093(3)(e), Florida Statutes.

6. Upon a finding by the Commission that the information highlighted in Exhibit A, and referenced in Exhibit C, is proprietary confidential business information, it should not be declassified for a period of at least eighteen (18) months and should be returned to FPL as soon as the information is no longer necessary for the Commission to conduct its business. *See* § 366.093(4), Florida Statutes.

WHEREFORE, FPL respectfully requests confidential classification of portions of its responses to Staff's First Set of Interrogatories (Nos. 1-28) and Staff's First Request for Production of Documents (Nos. 1-3).
