PROPOSED JULY 2010 DATA NOTIFICATION

BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., d/b/a AT&T Florida ("AT&T") is considering making the changes described in this document to generate results for the July 2010 data month. Results for the July 2010 data month will be posted as follows:

(1) Affected Measures: FT

O-3 Percent Flow-Through Service Requests [FT]

Description of Change: Currently, the aggregate and 12-month reports for Percent Flow-Through include affiliate data. AT&T proposes to modify the code to exclude the affiliate data from the Percent Flow-Through measure. This proposed change was item number one on the filed Preliminary July 2010 Data Notification. (RQ10821)

Impact of Change:

-For the March 2010 data-month in Florida, the CLEC metric for this change was not impacted for Residence, Business, and UNE-OTHER. For LNP Standalone, Percent Flow-Through changed from 99.14% to 99.01%. Due to the impact of this change, re-posting is not necessary.
