- ISSUE 1: Has Skyland presented evidence sufficient to invoke the Commission's exclusive jurisdiction over Skyland's application for original certificates for proposed water and wastewater systems?
  - A. Did Skyland provide evidence to support that it satisfies the definition of "utility" contained in Section 367.021(12), Florida Statutes?
  - B. Did Skyland provide evidence to support that the service proposed by Skyland transverses county boundaries pursuant to Section 367.171(7), Florida Statutes?
- POSITION: In Order No. PSC-10-0123A-PCO-WS, the Commission determined that from the face of the application the Commission has jurisdiction over this matter. On May 4, 2010, the Commission's Order on Jurisdiction and Denying Hernando County's Motion to Dismiss was per curium affirmed by the First District Court of Appeals. Accordingly, the Commission should not reconsider its legal determination regarding jurisdiction but only whether the application has met its factual burden of proof that it is within the Commission's jurisdiction.
