On April 26, 2010, the Commission issued Proposed Agency Action (PAA) Order No. PSC-10-0255-PAA-TX, made final and effective by Consummating Order (CO) No. PSC-10-0327-CO-TX, issued on May 21, 2010, in Docket No. 100112-TX. The PAA Order approved EveryCall Communications, Inc.'s (EveryCall's) proposal to issue a refund to affected customers for billing local number portability fees from April 2008 to October 2009. The PAA Order also directed EveryCall to submit a report and any amount due to customers who cannot be located to the Commission by October 29, 2010.

EveryCall submitted its final report and check in the amount of \$1,161.00 on May 28, 2010. Staff reviewed the report and determined that EveryCall has complied with the terms of the PAA Order. Therefore, this docket should be closed administratively.
