24	Item Number 2 addresses the 2011/2012 contract
25	option year with Sprint to provide Relay service for the

nearly 3 million deaf, hard of hearing, deaf/blind and 1 speech impaired citizens in Florida. 2 Staff is recommending that the Commission 3 exercise its contract option to extend the Sprint Relay 4 contract for the fourth contract option year beginning 5 June 1st, 2011, and ending May 31st, 2012. If approved 6 by the Commission, Florida's rates for the 2011/2012 7 contract year will be 89 cents per minute for 8 traditional Relay services and \$1.54 per minute for 9 10 CapTel captioning service. Ms. Dottie Cartrite and Ms. Maggie Schoolar of 11 Sprint Relay are participating by telephone this 12 morning, to be available should Commissioners have any 13 questions. Ms. Cartrite is the Florida contract manager 14 for Sprint and Ms. Schoolar is the national contract 15 manager for Sprint. And staff is available for 16 17 questions. CHAIRMAN ARGENZIANO: Thank you. 18 19 Commissioner Skop. COMMISSIONER SKOP: Thank you, Madam Chair. 20 21 I just wanted to say that I am in favor of the staff recommendation, but wanted to take this 22 23 opportunity specifically, as I've done for the two 24 previous years, to commend both Beth Salak and Rick Moses on staff. As a result of their efforts, the 25

cumulative savings on this agreement in the third option 1 vear have exceeded \$1.5 million, and those are savings 2 that are directly passed on to Florida ratepayers as a 3 result of asking questions in the negotiation process 4 that may have not been asked previously. So I would 5 like to commend our staff wholeheartedly for asking 6 those questions in the public interest. Again, by 7 ably -- by asking those questions and getting favorable 8 pricing on the contract option years, those savings are 9 tremendous. And, again, they should be commended and 10 that's why I do this every year. So thank you. 11 MR. CASEY: Thank you, Commissioner. 12 CHAIRMAN ARGENZIANO: Absolutely. Thank you, 13 Commissioner Skop. 14 And we do appreciate that. Good work. Great 15 16 work. Commissioner Edgar, any, any comments? 17 COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Ditto. 18 CHAIRMAN ARGENZIANO: Okay. All right. With 19 that said, any, any other discussion? A motion? 20 COMMISSIONER SKOP: Madam Chair, with respect 21 to the disposition of Item 2 before the Commission, I'd 22 move to approve the staff recommendation for Issues 23 1 and 2. 24 25 COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Second.
