Re: Request for Depreciation Rate for Perdido Landfill Gas to Energy Facility

Dear Mrs. Cole:

Pursuant to Rule 25-6.0436(2)(a), Gulf Power Company respectfully requests approval to initiate depreciation of a Landfill Gas to Energy Facility projected to be placed in service in August 2010. This Facility is located in Escambia County Florida and consists of two 1.6 MW landfill gas fired generators. Gulf Power is purchasing these combustion engines and the related equipment as a turnkey project when the facility achieves commercial in-service status.

Total projected cost to be incurred by Gulf Power for the facility will be approximately \$5.1 million that will be recorded within FERC accounts 340-346, Other Production. Gulf Power plans to depreciate this investment over the 20-year life of the Renewable Energy Facility.
