# FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY'S REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION OF EXHIBIT SRS-12 TO THE REBUTTAL TESTIMONY OF STEVEN R. SIM

Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") requests confidential classification of a portion of Exhibit SRS-12 to the rebuttal testimony of FPL Witness Steven R. Sim. In support of its request, FPL states as follows:

- 1. FPL is filing contemporaneously with this request the rebuttal testimony and exhibits of several witnesses in the above referenced docket, including the testimony and exhibits of FPL witness Steven R. Sim. Certain information within Exhibit SRS-12 is business proprietary, competitively sensitive information. Pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(4), Florida Administrative Code, FPL is filing this Request for Confidential Classification.
  - 2. The following exhibits are included with and made a part of this request:
  - a) Exhibit A is the confidential copy of Exhibit SRS-12, with the confidential portion highlighted.
  - b) Exhibit B is a redacted copy of Exhibit SRS-12, with the confidential portion blacked out.
  - c) Exhibit C is a table identifying the specific page and line or column numbers that are confidential, with references to the specific statutory bases for the claim of confidentiality and to the affidavit in support of the requested classification.
  - d) Exhibit D is the affidavit of Terry Jones in support of this request.

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- 3. FPL submits that the information in Exhibit A is proprietary confidential business information within the meaning of Section 366.093(3), Florida Statutes. This information is intended to be and is treated by FPL as private, and its confidentiality has been maintained. Pursuant to Section 366.093, such information is entitled to confidential treatment and it is exempt from the disclosure provisions of the public records law. Thus, once the Commission determines that the information in question is proprietary confidential business information, the Commission is not required to engage in any further analysis or review such as weighing the harm of disclosure against the public interest in access to the information.
- 4. As the affidavit included in Exhibit D indicates, the information provided by FPL contains competitively sensitive information that will be used in negotiations with vendors and help ensure the reasonableness of vendor cost estimates. Public disclosure of this information would impair FPL's negotiations with vendors for favorable contract terms, to the ultimate detriment of FPL's customers. Such information is protected by Section 366.093(3)(d) and Section 366.093(3)(e), Florida Statutes.
- 5. Upon a finding by the Commission that the information included in Exhibit A, and referenced in Exhibit C, is proprietary confidential business information, the information should not be declassified for a period of at least eighteen (18) months and should be returned to FPL as soon as the information is no longer necessary for the Commission to conduct its business. See § 366.093(4), Fla. Stat.

**WHEREFORE,** FPL respectfully requests confidential classification of the confidential portion of Exhibit SRS-12 as described herein.
