FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY'S REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION OF THE PRICEWATERHOUSECOOPERS LLP APPRAISAL REPORT

Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") requests confidential classification of the Estimate of the Fair Market Value of the Seabrook NED Substation of Florida Power & Light Co. as of June 1, 2010 (the "Appraisal Report") prepared by PricewaterhouseCoopers LLP ("PwC"). In support of its request, FPL states as follows:

- 1. In Order PSC-10-0153-FOF-EI, the Commission directed that FPL provide the Commission with an independent appraisal as to the fair market value of the FPL NED assets.
- 2. In response to the Commission's direction, FPL engaged PwC to perform an independent appraisal of those assets.
- 3. PwC has recently concluded its appraisal and has issued the Appraisal Report. This Request is intended to request confidential classification of the Appraisal Report consistent with Rule 25-22.006(3), Florida Administrative Code.
 - 4. The following exhibits are included with and made a part of this request:
- a. Exhibit A includes a copy of the confidential Appraisal Report on which all information that is entitled to confidential treatment under Florida law has been highlighted.
- b. Exhibit B consists of a page noting that the full Appraisal Report is designated confidential.

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- c. Exhibit C is a table containing references to the specific statutory basis or bases for the claim of confidentiality and to the affidavit in support of the requested classification.
- d. Exhibit D is the affidavit of Kimberly Ousdahl attesting to the basis for confidentiality of the Appraisal Report.
- 5. FPL submits that the highlighted information in Exhibit A is proprietary confidential business information within the meaning of Section 366.093(3), Florida Statutes. This information is intended to be and is treated by PwC and FPL as private, and its confidentiality has been maintained. Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, such information is entitled to confidential treatment and it is exempt from the disclosure provisions of the public records law. Thus, once the Commission determines that the information in question is proprietary confidential business information, the Commission is not required to engage in any further analysis or review such as weighing the harm of disclosure against the public interest in access to the information.
- 6. As attested in Ms. Ousdahl's affidavit, PwC considers the contents of the Appraisal Report to be confidential and expressly forbids its access, use or distribution beyond its client (*i.e.*, FPL) and those authorized by PwC and the client. FPL is required pursuant to the Appraisal Report to seek designation of the Appraisal Report as confidential by the Commission. The Appraisal Report is entitled to confidential designation because it contains information that is competitively sensitive to PwC, and its disclosure could impair PwC's competitive interests. See § 366.093(3)(e), Fla. Stat.
- 7. Upon a finding by the Commission that the information contained in the Appraisal Report is proprietary confidential business information, the information should not be

declassified for a period of at least eighteen (18) months and should be returned to FPL as soon as the information is no longer necessary for the Commission to conduct its business. See § 366.093(4), Fla. Stat.

WHEREFORE, for the above and foregoing reasons, as more fully set forth in the supporting materials and affidavits included herewith, Florida Power & Light Company respectfully requests that its Request for Confidential Classification be granted
