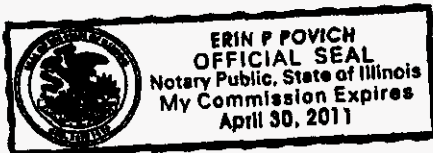



On July 13, 2010, the Florida Public Service Commission issued Order No. PSC-10-0474-TRF-WS, in Docket No. 100313-WS, approving a change to UTILITIES, INC.'s (the "Utility") Tariffs to allow it to collect Non-Sufficient Funds ("NSF") charges. This Notice of implementation of NSF Charges applies to customers of the following Utilities, Inc. companies:

**ALAFAYA UTILITIES, INC.  
CYPRESS LAKES UTILITIES, INC.  
LABRADOR UTILITIES, INC.  
LAKE UTILITY SERVICES, INC.  
MID-COUNTY SERVICES, INC.  
TIERRA VERDE UTILITIES, INC.  
UTILITIES, INC. OF EAGLE RIDGE**

The NSF Check charges that may be levied pursuant to Section 68.065 and Section 832.08(5), Florida Statutes, when a customer pays by check and that check is dishonored by the customer's banking institution. The Utility will charge the amount set by Section 68.065 and Section 832.08(5), Florida Statutes, as may be amended. As currently set forth in Section 832.08(5), the following fees may be assessed:

- 1) \$25, if the face value does not exceed \$50,
- 2) \$30, if the face value exceeds \$50 but does not exceed \$300,
- 3) \$40, if the face value exceeds \$300,
- 4) or five percent (5%) of the face amount of the check, whichever is greater.

These NSF charges are effective for service on or after August 18, 2010.

This notice was prepared by the Utility and approved by the Commission Staff for distribution by the Utility to its customers.
