On September 2, 2010 at 1:56 PM Commissioner Argenziano's office received a phone call from Florida Power & Light Company.

I did not answer the phone out of caution regarding *ex parte* communications: although a matter discussed may be procedural, no satisfactory assurances can be provided to outside parties that the discussion is appropriately limited to procedural matters, unless the conversation is recorded. Additionally, the phone-call was unusual—the first time while serving in my current position that I received a call from Florida Power & Light Company. Thus, out of caution regarding *ex parte* communications and due to the unusual nature of the call, I did not answer, and let the call go to voicemail.

The caller identified himself as Mr. Ken Hoffman. He stated that he was calling on a procedural matter: "to let [us] know that FPL had filed a motion to disqualify Commissioner Skop in the FPL dockets."

No substantive information was conveyed to Chairman Argenziano. She was informed that Florida Power & Light Company called to notify us that they filed a motion to disqualify Commissioner Skop in the FPL dockets.

The voicemail corroborating the nature of this communication will be placed in the record as soon as practicable.
