(collectively "Verizon") hereby submit this Application for authority under Section 214(a) of the Communications Act and Section 63.71 of the Commission's rules to discontinue (1) Special Access High Capacity DS1C service in Verizon's remaining service territory in the following areas: California, Florida, Texas, the former GTE areas in Pennsylvania and Virginia and the former Contel areas in Pennsylvania, Virginia and North Carolina and (2) Special Access High Capacity DS3C service in Verizon's remaining service territory in the following areas: California, Florida, Texas, and the former GTE areas in Pennsylvania and Virginia. ## 2. Date of Planned Service Discontinuance (47 C.F.R. §§ 63.71(a)(2), (b)(2)):

Subject to Commission authorization under 47 C.F.R. § 63.71 Verizon will

discontinue Special Access High Capacity DS1C and DS3C services in the impacted

areas on or after December 2, 2010.

# 3. Points of Geographic Areas of Service Affected (47 C.F.R. §§ 63.71(a)(3), b(2)):

Subject to Commission authorization under 47 C.F.R. § 63.71 Verizon will

discontinue (1) Special Access High Capacity DS1C service in Verizon's remaining service territory in the following areas: California, Florida, Texas, the former GTE areas in Pennsylvania and Virginia, and the former Contel areas in Pennsylvania, Virginia and North Carolina and (2) Special Access High Capacity DS3C service in Verizon's remaining service territory in the following areas: California, Florida, Texas, the former GTE areas in Pennsylvania and Virginia.<sup>1</sup>

## 4. Brief Description of Type of Service Affected (47 C.F.R. §§ 63.71(a)(4), b(2)):

Verizon's Special Access High Capacity DS1C and DS3C services provide dedicated high capacity facilities between customer designated locations or between a customer designated location and a Telephone Company designated Hub Wire Center where multiplexing is offered. Verizon's Special Access High Capacity DS1C and DS3C services provide for the transmission of isochronous bipolar serial data at the rate of 3.152 Mbps (DS1C) or 89.472 Mbps (DS3C), respectively.

The public convenience and necessity will not be impaired by the proposed service discontinuance. Currently, there are no customers for Verizon's Special Access High Capacity DS1C and DS3C in the impacted areas. In addition, suppliers of Special Access High Capacity DS1C and DS3C communications equipment have discontinued manufacturing the equipment required to provision these services and as a result parts for these services are no longer readily available. Finally, Verizon and other providers offer alternatives to the services being discontinued. As an example, DS3s are one alternative to DS1Cs.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> The areas in which Verizon's Special Access High Capacity DS1C and DS3C services are being discontinued differs slightly because unlike Verizon's DS1C service, Verizon's DS3C service is not offered in Verizon's FCC Tariff No. 16, which covers the former Contel regions.

# 5. Brief Description of the Dates and Methods of Notice to All Affected Customers (47 C.F.R. § 63.71 (b)(3)):

In the impacted areas, there currently are no customers for the services being discontinued. Accordingly, there are no customers to notify about the proposed discontinuance.

public utilities commissions of each impacted state, and the Special Assistant for

Telecommunications to the Secretary of Defense, as required by Section 63.71(a) of the

Commission's rules.

# 6. Regulatory Classification of Carrier (47 C.F.R. § 63.71(b)(4)):

Verizon is considered dominant with respect to the services to be discontinued.
