II. Description of Proposed Transactions

Scott Heath and Andrea Hylan have entered into a Stock Purchase Agreement under which Hylan will acquire from Heath all of the issued and outstanding shares of Nationwide Long Distance Service, Inc. The consideration to be paid is all cash. Upon consummation of the proposed transaction, Hylan will own 100% interest in Nationwide Long Distance Service, Inc.

There is no plan to notify customers. There will be no impact on customers, since the transaction will be transparent to customers, because the transfer of control will only result in a change in ownership. There will be no change in name, and the company will continue to provide services pursuant to the same terms and conditions.

III. Public Interest Analysis

The proposed transaction is in the public interest because it will enhance Nationwide Long Distance Service, Inc.'s ability to compete in the market for telecommunications services. The transaction will have no adverse effect upon customers. It will give NLDS access to resources which will enable it to introduce new products and services and to respond to the competitive environment.

In addition, the contact points for customers and Commission inquiries will remain the same immediately after the transfer of control. Nor does the proposed transfer of control raise any competitive concerns.
