**RE:** Docket No. 100330-WS, Application for increase in water/wastewater rates in Alachua, Brevard, DeSoto, Hardee, Highlands, Lake, Lee, Marion, Orange, Palm Beach, Pasco, Polk, Putnam, Seminole, Sumter, Volusia, and Washington Counties by Aqua Utilities Florida, Inc. (AUF)

I called Troy Rendell of AUF on Friday, Sept. 10th. I left him a message, asking him to verify whether the following data in AUF's Minimum Filing Requirements (MFR) Schedule E-14 (billing analysis) is correct:

- 1) Band 2, wastewater: Schedule E-14 includes residential 3/4" meters, but there are no corresponding residential 3/4" meters listed in Band 2 for water.
- 2) Band 2, wastewater: Schedule E-14 includes commercial service 3" and 4" meters, but there are no corresponding commercial 3" or 4" meters listed in Band 2 for water.
- 3) Band 3, wastewater: Schedule E-14 includes commercial service 4" meters, but there are no corresponding commercial 4" meters listed in Band 3 for water.

Mr. Rendell returned my call today, Monday Sept. 13th. He responded that the information in the MFRs is correct. He explained that in the current capband rate structure, a system's water customers may be in one band (i.e., band 1), while its wastewater customers may be in another band (i.e., band 2). This situation creates the apparent anomalies referenced above.
