By a copy of this memorandum, we recommend that the Clerk return confidential Document No. 08082-10 to the source.

Further, we recommend that documents 05832-06 and 06113-06 be granted a second 18-month extension of confidential classification.

Confidential document 08082-10 was filed along with a request for a second extension of the confidential classification period for materials collected during the 2005 FPL Conservation Cost Recovery Clause Audit (Documents 05832-06 and 06113-06). Staff recommends that the specified areas of Document Nos. 05832-06 and 06113-06 be classified as requested as confidential for an additional 18 months. FPL has requested that a reduced amount of sensitive material be held for the extended classification period. FPL has requested that just customer-specific account information and information concerning salaries of specific employees remain confidential.

FPL's public listing of the sensitive information can be found within Clerk's Document No. 08084-10 and FPL's public redacted copies of this material may be found within Clerk's Document Nos. 06114-06 and 08083-10.

Confidential Document No. 08082-10 was filed by FPL in support of this extension of the confidential classification, but this information duplicates information found within the FPL's 2006 filing, Document No. 06113-06.

Thus, confidential document 08082-10 is not needed to support FPL's request and may be returned to the source.
