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## PROCEEDINGS

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CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Okay. Time to get into the agenda. Let's turn to Item Number 6, please. Traci

Matthews, it sounds like you're going to be introducing

this. I'm sorry. We'll give you guys a second.

MS. MATTHEWS: Good morning, Commissioners.

I'm Traci Matthews, Commission Staff.

Item 6 is a petition from Florida Public Utilities Company for approval of its 2010 DSM plan. FPUC's DSM plan as it was originally filed did not meet the goals approved by the Commission in all areas. However, after the Commission's vote on September 14th, 2010, FPUC revised its plan to remove two programs that were not cost-effective and to include savings estimates related to the Company's solar pilot programs.

Staff has determined that the revised plan does in fact meet or exceed the goals in all areas. FPUC will be required to file program standards within 30 days of the consummating order. Staff is recommending that the Commission approve FPUC's 2010 DSM plan. Staff is ready to answer any questions you may have.

CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: First to the board, board members, anybody have any questions of Staff or

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COMMISSIONER SKOP: Thank you, Commissioner

On Issue 3, page 12, please. All right. At the top of the page, first paragraph, it says, "FPUC has no experience with respect to the penetration levels for solar thermal programs." Do you know what the projected penetration rates were? They're not listed on the, in the Staff recommendation for both its solar thermal and solar PV programs.

MS. MATTHEWS: That's right, Commissioner. the filing that FPUC provided as an addition to the original filing they did give us those numbers. I did not include them in the recommendation. But for PV they estimated eight participants to be added to the program

COMMISSIONER SKOP: Okay. And that's both solar thermal and solar PV or --

MS. MATTHEWS: Actually, no. For the solar thermal they estimated 12.

COMMISSIONER SKOP: Okay. All right. Great. And that would be cumulative, so it would be first year eight and then 16.

MS. MATTHEWS: Yes. That's correct.

1 COMMISSIONER SKOP: All right. Great. right. And then with respect to Issue 4, I'd ask Staff 2 to turn there, Ms. Matthews, please. 3 Okay. And looking at the graphs, does Staff 4 know why there's a decrease in the winter demand goal 5 for the 2009 through 2019 period compared to the 2004 6 7 through 2014 period? MS. MATTHEWS: They really didn't explain 8 that. They didn't say why that was. That was just 9 based on the estimations that they gave us on the 10 11 savings. COMMISSIONER SKOP: Okay. All right. Very 12 well. I just wanted to clarify those points. So thank 13 14 you. CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Thank you, Commissioner 15 Skop. 16 Anything else from the board? Seeing none, 17 can I call for a motion? 18 COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Mr. Chair, I can move 19 Staff recommendation on Issues 1 through 5, all issues 20 21 on Item 6. COMMISSIONER SKOP: Second. 22 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: It's been moved and seconded 23 24 to move Staff on Item 6. Any further discussion? Seeing none, all in favor, signify by saying aye. 25
