CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Item 7. Did you guys ever play musical chairs when you were a kid? Wait for the music to stop.

Ms. Watts, it looks like you're introducing this one.

MS. WATTS: Yes. Melinda Watts for Commission Staff.

And, Commissioners, Item 7 is Staff's recommendation in Docket Number 100399-TP, on the request for waiver of the carrier selection requirements of Rule 25-4.118, Florida Administrative Code, and the transfer of customers from American Fiber Network, Inc., and CloseCall America, Inc., to Birch Telecom of the South, Inc. And Staff is available if you have any questions.

CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Thank you, Ms. Watts.

Anything from the Commission? Commissioner

COMMISSIONER SKOP: Ms. Watts, with respect to the recommendation, on the caption line I guess it's a request for expedited waiver, but in the remainder of the recommendation it just requests for a waiver. Can Staff elaborate on that a little bit, please?

MS. WATTS: The title was basically what is, was requested by the Company. That's what they titled their filing. And they do that because they're trying to do this in several states, and some states require that they file these, you know, so they're trying to close their transaction in time in Florida. They are not required to have, to file this at all. They can do it if they like. And they are, you know, they're not under a time crunch with Florida. They can close their transaction without it. So we really don't address the time issue.

COMMISSIONER SKOP: Okay. Very well. With respect to the acquiring company, which I believe is Birch, that's seeking the waiver so that the customers won't have to provide individual authorizations, what do we know, if anything, about Birch as a company? I noticed on page 4 of the Staff recommendation they indicated that there is no outstanding regulatory assessment fees or penalties, but typically in the past in telecom we've had some problems. I just wanted to seek Staff's input with respect to the proposed waiver of the acquiring company.

MS. WATTS: I've worked with Birch several times on certain issues. Most often they've approached me for help in going over the wording of their letters

of agency to make sure that they comply with our rules, 1 and they've always complied with any suggestions that 2 we've had. And they've applied for waivers in the past 3 and, you know, we've always seemed to have a fairly good 4 5 working relationship with them. COMMISSIONER SKOP: Okay. Very well. And 6 then on page 3 of the Staff recommendation, it says for, 7 if for any reason the transaction -- excuse me. "If for 8

MS. WATTS: Yes, sir.
