Re: Request of American Fiber Systems, Inc. to Surrender its Authorizations

Dear Ms. Cole:

American Fiber Systems, Inc. ("AFS"), by its undersigned counsel, requests that the Commission cancel its Authorizations granted by, and rescind all tariffs on file with, the Commission, effective as soon as possible. AFS is authorized to provide (1) interexchange telecommunications services pursuant to authorization (now IXC Registration No. TJ487) granted in Docket No. 001716-TI on March 7, 2001 and (2) alternative local exchange telecommunication services pursuant to Certificate No. 7769 issued in Docket No. 00717-TX on April 5, 2001 (the "Authorizations").

AFS does not provide intrastate telecommunications services in Florida and has no plans to do so in the future. AFS, therefore, no longer requires its Authorization. Because AFS does not serve any customers or have any active telecommunications operations in Florida, AFS respectfully submits that the surrender of its Authorization and withdrawal of its tariffs is reasonable and necessary and will not be disruptive to the present or future public interest, convenience and necessity.
