JOINT PETITION FOR APPROVAL OF STIPULATION AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

Peoples Gas System ("Peoples" or the "Company") and the Office of Public Counsel ("OPC") hereby petition the Commission to approve the Stipulation and Settlement Agreement dated December 16, 2010, and attached hereto, which the joint petitioners have entered into for the resolution of all issues relating to any overearnings of Peoples for the calendar year ending December 31, 2010. In support of this petition, the joint petitioners represent as follows:

- 3. Peoples is a public utility as defined by Section 366.02, *Florida Statutes*, and subject to the regulatory jurisdiction of the Commission established by Chapter 366, *Florida Statutes*. The OPC provides legal representation for the people of the State of Florida in proceedings before the Commission as authorized and directed by Section 350.0611, *Florida Statutes*.
- 4. Primarily as a result of record low temperatures in Florida during the first quarter of 2010, it became apparent that Peoples' earnings might exceed the top of the return on equity ("ROE") range established in Order No. PSC-09-0411-FOF-GU in Docket No. 080318-GU, the Company's last full base rate proceeding. Representatives of Peoples, OPC and the Commission Staff ("Staff") met in Tallahassee in early June 2010 after Peoples filed its Earnings Surveillance Report ("ESR") for the first quarter of 2010. As requested by Staff, by letter dated June 9, 2010, Peoples agreed, subject to certain conditions, to cap its earned ROE for calendar year 2010 at 11.75 percent, the top of the range established by Order No. PSC-09-0411-FOF-GU. Subsequent ESRs submitted by the Company for the second and third calendar quarters of 2010 reflected an earned ROE above the top of the authorized range.
- 5. The joint petitioners engaged in discussions and negotiations, initiated by Peoples, for the purpose of reaching a comprehensive stipulation in settlement of all

issues arising from overearnings by Peoples for the calendar year ending December 31, 2010, thereby avoiding the need for potentially expensive, time-consuming litigation in hearings or other proceedings before the Commission. These negotiations have culminated in the execution of the attached Stipulation and Settlement Agreement. Petitioners request that following review by the Commission of the Stipulation and Settlement Agreement, the Commission will consider and approve the same at the earliest agenda conference practicable.

- 6. The Stipulation and Settlement Agreement provides for, among other things, a prompt refund of \$3,000,000.00 to Peoples' customers in the form of a one-time credit to customers' bills, with the balance of any 2010 overearnings to be used to correct or mitigate deficiencies in the Company's depreciation reserves.
- 7. Petitioners represent that the Stipulation and Settlement Agreement fairly and reasonably balances the interests of the Company and the short term and long term interests of its customers on issues arising from the Company's overearnings for the calendar year 2010, and that its approval by the Commission will serve the public interest. The Stipulation and Settlement Agreement is fully consistent with and supportive of the Commission's long-standing policy of encouraging the settlement of proceedings in a manner that benefits the ratepayers of utilities subject to the Commission's regulatory jurisdiction, and will avoid the need for costly and time-consuming litigation of the subject matter before the Commission.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, the joint petitioners respectfully request that the Commission approve in its entirety the Stipulation and Settlement
