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Re: DSLnet Communications, LLC Request to Surrender its Authorizations

Dear Ms. Cole:

DIECA Communications, Inc. ("DIECA") as successor in interest to DSLnet Communications, LLC ("DSLnet"), by undersigned counsel, requests that the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") cancel DSLnet's authorizations to provide intrastate telecommunications and rescind any and all tariffs on file with, the Commission. DSLnet was granted authority to provide alternate local exchange telecommunications services in Docket No. 990163-TX and interexchange telecommunications services in Docket No. 990164-TI.

On December 31, 2011, DSLnet completed a transaction with its affiliate DIECA whereby DSLnet merged with and into DIECA with DIECA surviving the merger.¹ As a result of the transaction, DSLnet no longer offers services in Florida and therefore no longer requires its authorizations. Because DSLnet does not serve any intrastate telecommunications customers in Florida, the company respectfully submits that the surrender of its authorizations is reasonable and necessary and will not be disruptive to the present or future public interest, convenience and necessity.
