PETITION FOR EXPEDITED REVIEW OF GROWTH CODE DENIAL

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BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T Florida ("AT&T Florida"), pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 52.15(g)(iv), Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") Order FCC 00-104, and Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") Order No. PSC-01-1973-PCO-TL, petitions the Commission to review the Pooling Administrator's ("NeuStar") denial of AT&T Florida's requests for additional numbering resources in the Miami exchange. In support of this petition, AT&T Florida states:

PARTIES

1. AT&T Florida is a corporation organized and formed under the laws of the State of Georgia and an incumbent local exchange company ("ILEC") regulated by the Commission and authorized to provide local exchange telecommunications and intraLATA toll telecommunications in the State of Florida.

2. NeuStar is an independent non-governmental entity, which is responsible for administering and managing the numbering resources in pooling areas. See 47 C.F.R. § 52.20(d).

JURISDICTION

3. The Commission has jurisdiction of this matter pursuant to Industry Numbering Committees (INC) Number Pooling Guidelines Sections 3.7 and 12(c). This provision provides that a carrier may challenge NeuStar's decision to deny numbering est and the sec resources to the appropriate regulatory authority.

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BACKGROUND AND REQUEST FOR RELIEF

4. The Boynton Beach exchange consists of one central office and one switching entity that utilize numbering resources: Main (BYBHFLMADS0).

5. On December 2, 2011, AT&T Florida requested additional numbering resources from NeuStar for the Main (BYBHFLMADS0) switch. See Attachments 1. Specifically, AT&T Florida requested a 1,000 consecutive numbers in the format of 561 NXX-7XXX.

6. At the time of the code request, the Boynton Beach exchange had a MTE of 36.81 and a utilization of 66.28%.

7. On December 2, 2011, NeuStar's automated number request system denied AT&T Florida's request for additional numbering resources because AT&T Florida had not met the utilization based criteria, notwithstanding the fact that AT&T Florida is unable to provide the numbering resources requested by the specific customer. <u>See</u> Attachment 1. Pursuant to Commission Order No. PSC-01-1973-PCO-TL, attached to this Petition is the customer's contact information. <u>See</u> Attachment 2.

8. As discussed above, both the FCC Order and the INC guidelines provide that state regulatory authorities have the power and authority to review NeuStar's decision to deny a request for numbering resources. <u>See</u> INC Number Pooling Guidelines Sections 3.7 and 12(c).

9. Under earlier MTE procedures used by NANPA, waivers or exceptions were granted when customer hardships could be demonstrated or when the service provider's inventory did not have a block of sequential numbers large enough to meet the customer's specific request. Under existing procedures, NeuStar nor NANPA looks at

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the number of MTE and utilization for the entire rate center without exception. The current process is arbitrary and results in (1) decisions contrary to the public interest and welfare of consumers in the State of Florida; and (2) decisions that do not necessarily promote the efficient use of telephone numbers.

10. AT&T Florida requests that the Commission's reverse NeuStar's decision to withhold numbering resources from AT&T Florida on the following grounds:

(a) NeuStar's denial of numbering resources to AT&T Florida interferes with
 AT&T Florida's ability to serve its customers within the State of Florida.

(b) As a result of NeuStar's denial of AT&T Florida's request for additional numbering resources, AT&T Florida will be unable to provide telecommunications services to its customers as required under Florida law.

WHEREFORE, AT&T Florida requests:

1. The Commission review the decision of NeuStar to deny AT&T Florida's request for additional numbering resources for the Boynton Beach exchange; and

2. The Commission direct NeuStar to provide the requested numbering resources for the Boynton Beach exchange as discussed above.
